


JCHYK Youth Retreat

SwamiJi Dheerananda has a pun on the acronym GPS; Similar to the well known acronym Global Positioning System, Guru Parampara Sampradaya helps us realize our bearings with reference to rest of the Universe.

Guru Parampara ensures: Intellectual integrity, Clarity of Thought and Precise understanding. Without a Guru all these are not possible. And without Chitta Shuddhi or Purity of understanding, dilemma can't be removed. And peace and tranquility is not possible until this dilemma is gone.

This is the reason, Purandara Dasa says: "One may memorize hundreds of scriptural texts; but Salvation is not possible until one obediently follows the Guru".

Guru Parampara System removes the arrogance of 'doership': every Guru, — including Veda Vyasa and Adi Shankara — does not take credit to inventing some new religion or inventing a new school of thought. They either say "this is what my Guru told me" or they will say "this is what is told in Vedas"

True to the GPS spirit, VijayJi, too is passionate about Gurudev Chinmayananda's vision of "maximum happiness to maximum number of people". He has started innumerable Study Groups in the Washington area, in order to make learning centers easily accessible to the seeker. VijayJi believes in Gurudev's vision of societal transformation through individual transformation. A society thrives with stability, peace and prosperity, when its subjects are at peace with

themselves; when individuals are not greedy but work towards a common good, in "Yajna Spirit", society becomes Rama Rajya.

About VijayJi: many of you have shared your experiences: I remember a couple of them:

First: when he arrived in Washington DC area in late 1980s, as soon he unpacked and setup his home, VijayJi went in search of Bhagavad Geetha book and borrowed a copy from SadaJi. Result: Virginia chapter of Chinmaya Mission Washington Regional Center and about 40 satellite study groups, from Ocean City to Frederick, MD to Richmond, VA and beyond to North Carolina.



 Introduction – "An Embodiment of Ideal Sannyasa" written by Swami Sivananda

There is a significant saying that while sacred shrines and tirthas purify and sanctify all mankind, the sacred places and tirthas are themselves more sanctified and divinized by the holy men and saints who grace them with their passing footprints or prolonged presence.

Sri Swami Tapovanji Maharaj of Uttarkashi is a lofty example of this type of most blessed souls.

He commenced his life with complete indifference towards worldly wealth and position, for he was born with the Sannyasa ideal foremost in his heart. Swami Tapovanam embodied Sannyasa, as observed by Sri Adi Sankara in 'Dhanya-Ashtakam', "leaving off all love for one's house which is the basic cause of all our miserable downfall, induced by the thirst of Self-knowledge, drinking the elixir of the Truth of the Upanishadic declarations, devoid of all desires at the heart, with extreme dispassion for the host of the objects of enjoyment, fortunate souls wander in solitude giving up all company and attachment!"

Swami Tapovanam set before himself the ideal portrayed in the Geeta by the Lord. He embodied within himself all

the virtues enumerated in the seventeenth Chapter as constituting the three from of tapas – bodily, verbal and mental. An erudite scholar that he was, he restrained his Vach-Indriya and sublimated the yearning to pour himself out and shed the light of learning that filled his heart on one and all who came in contact with him. Unostentatiously, he would remain in his kutir contemplating again on the Truth which he had already long meditated upon and realized. Silently and within himself, he would put every one of the Hindu philosophical theories that he had learned so far to the test of actual realization. In the evening, he would pour out doses of the rarest spiritual nectar to a select band of aspirants who would listen to him spellbound; for every word that flowed from his lips then had not only the supreme authority of the Vedas, but had passed through the test of his own realization. These sublime thoughts would, as they proceeded direct from his heart, take deep root in the listeners in whom they would invariably produce a complete reorientation.

His life and personality demonstrate the great secret of the relationship between Vedanta and Sannyasa. Vedanta and Sannyasa go hand in hand. One does not become complete without the other. Wherever this Sannyasa, there is practical Vedanta, wherever there is practical Vedanta there must be Sannyasa of the highest type. When in one Sannyasa and Vedanta melt into one, there crops up a sage of Supreme Wisdom. Verily Sri Swami Tapovanamji has achieved such a state to a unique degree. His towering personality is an eye-opener and an exemplary guide and light to all seekers and Sannyasins.

Sri Tapovanamji is giving to the world in his autobiography 'Iswara Darshan', his unique and valuable experiences for, with all his love of solitude, his love for humanity is equally great. The fruits of his prolonged life of Sadhana in seclusion and his rich inner life of realization, are bestowed upon all for their benefit and upliftment. It contains the most valuable records of his experiences and is a treasure that is to be imbibed fully by one and all.

Iswara Darshanam - IV

Discussion of the 11th Chapter of Geeta - Acharya Sadanandaji

In the chapters 7 and 9, the tat padartha is exhaustively discussed. In essence Iswara is defined as that from which the whole world arises, sustains, and goes back into. That is, He is sRiShTi, sthithi and laya kAraNam. That in fact provides the definition of Iswara. All religions stop at Iswara or God as intelligent cause for the universe, while Vedanta defines him, as Shankara puts it – abhinna nimitta upAdAna kAraNam –He is both the intelligent and material cause, and yet he is kaarya-kAraNa vilakshaNam Brahman, he is beyond any cause-effect relationships. Thus, he is the cause for creation, and yet He as Brahman is beyond the cause-effect relationships. This is being pointed in the slokas that says – mastAni sarva bhUtAni – all beings are in Me and at the same time – na cha mastAni bhUtAni – no beings are in Me. Iswara is defined as parA prakRiti while the apara prakRiti constitute all the pachabhutas. This is pointed in Ch. 7 in slokas bhUmirApO2nalovAyuH.... and aparEyamitastvanyAm... slokas 4 and 5.

Arjuna says in the first sloka of Ch.11 –madanugrahAyato bless me, adhyaatma sanj<mark>nitam – about the absolute</mark> truth that indicates (lakshyArttha)- the identity of the jiiva and Iswara, the ind<mark>ividua</mark>l and the Lord, which is paramam guhyam – which is the most sacred and secret. It is sacred in the sense that is the ultimate knowledge knowing which there is nothing more to know, and it is secret since no one believes if it this truth is told since for many their minds are not prepared enough to recognize this absolute fact - manushyAnAm sahasreShu.... Of the thousands of people, very few are ready to listen, says Krishna. Arjuna, here, acknowledges and says you have provided that supreme secret teaching because of which all my delusion has been eliminated. Illusion is appearance of one into many. Delusion is taking this apparent plurality as reality. Hence removal of delusion involves recognizing that the plurality that is perceived is not real but the reality is that which supports that plurality. The teaching that provides this understanding is paramam, guhyam, adhyaamta sanjnitam - the most sacred and secret teaching that involves the absolute truth, since it eliminated my delusion, says Arjuna.

Thus Arjuna acknowledges that he has received the essential teaching of the Lord who taught this supreme knowledge out of compassion to bless him, madanugrahAya. We discussed that Arujana summarized

in his first sloka of Ch. 11 the Krishna's teaching of the first six chapters that deals with tvam padartham. In the 2nd sloka he summarizes the tat padartham discussed in the chapters from 7 to 10.

In the second sloka, he calls the Lord as kamalapatrAksh, the lotus-leaf-eyed one. Lotus plays a prominent role in Vedanta teaching. Lotus is a plant that grows in a mud, yet beautifies its surroundings. Lotus leaves spread out on the dirty waters, yet unaffected by the water. Lakshmi is seen standing on the lotus flower. Here, Arjuna addresses Krishna as lotus-leaf eyed one – indicative of the eye that has clear vision of the truth in spite of the muddy surroundings, and unaffected by the surroundings. In this sloka, Arjuna says he understood the teaching that explains that the Lord is the cause for whole universe of things and beings. Arjuna says - bhUtAnAm - that includes panca bhUtas and also indicates all the beings in all the lokas or worlds, thus covers the entire sentient and insentient things and beings, hi - indeed, bhavApyaya bhava means creation or utpatti and apyaya means desolation - thus the whole creation and desolation of the world of beings and things, tattvataH – from you. By implication, we have to include sustenance also. Thus Arjuna says I have understood that you are the source from which all beings are born and are the locus for desolation. Here Lord is both nimitta kAraNam and upAdAna kAraNam – both the intelligent and the material cause. Krishna indicated earlier that he is the source for everything - gatir bhartA prabhu sAkshi ... indicating the Upanishadic statement - yatovA imAni **bhUtAni jAyante.**, where, Brahman is being defined as that from which the whole universe arises, sustains and goes back into. That is the essential truth.

Arjuna says in the sloka that he also understood that this creation-sustenance-and dissolution cycle does not affect the Lord since it is creation-less creation or transformation-less transformation. Hence Arjuna describes based on his understanding that Lord is avyayam and mAhAtmyam — essentially summarizing the 10th chapter of Geeta as everything is His vibhUti and He indestructible and yet providing the basis for the glorious creation that continuously changes. Arjuna says, you have provided me an exhaustible description of the whole teachings — vistarashaH. I have listened to the teaching carefully. The whole lower prakRiti arises from you,

sustained by you and go back into you while your absolute nature is beyond the time and space, yet providing the support for the whole creation. Arjuna says to Krishna, I understand clearly that *-te-* both, the origination and destruction of the universe, are from you, *tvattaH*. Hence Arjuna understood that sRishTi-sthithi- laya kaaraH, Brahman is none other than Krishna, himself. This is how Brahma sUtras define Brahman in the second sutra *- janmAdyasya yataH*.
